### Sports Day 2019

This year we are going to trial splitting sports day onto two different dates to allow all children to enjoy their sporting activities in a more relaxed, less time pressured way.

**KS2 Sports Day is Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> July** (Years 3,4,5 and 6)

**KS1 Sports Day is Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> July** (Reception, Year 1 and 2)

Both Sports Days will be in the morning – **9:15-12:00**

Please send your child into school wearing a **t-shirt in the colour of their team**. If you are unsure of their team colour please speak to your child's class teacher. Children will also need to wear their **black PE shorts and trainers**. They will wear this for the whole day.

#### Arrangements for the day

Parents are invited to stay in the playground after dropping the children off at 8:45(KS2)/8:50 (KS1). The children will be registered as usual in their class rooms and will brought onto the field, ready to start the events at 9:15. Both sports days will be held on the **KS2 field**.

We kindly ask that parents remain behind a fenced off area while the children complete a carousel of activities, as this allows the children to enjoy all of the activities without too much distraction and will ensure a smooth transition between events. During the events the **PTA will be selling drinks and food** for parents to buy. **Ice lollies** will be sold for parents but please **do not** buy one for your child. We will be giving every child a free ice lolly once the events have finished.



After all classes have completed the carousel of events, they will be participating in races at the back of the KS2 field. At this time, parents will be able to move closer to the race track, but we please ask that you don't come too close to the track so that we can ensure that all children can complete their races safely.

After all the children have raced, we will be having a mums' race and a dads' race. If you would like to participate in these races there will be **sign-up sheets on the day, on a table near to where the PTA will be selling drinks and food**. Please sign up while the children are completing the carousel of events. You will not be able to sign up once the class races have begun.

The races will be **finished by 12:00 on KS2 Sports day and by 11:45 for KS1 Sport Day**. We kindly ask that parents make a swift exit from the school after this time as we will need to get ready for lunch time.

#### Nursery Sports Day

The children in the Nursery will be having their own mini sports day in the nursery garden on **Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> July** (same day as KS1 Sports Day)

Morning Nursery: 10:00 – 10:30

Afternoon Nursery: 1:45 – 2:15

Please send your child into nursery on the day wearing a **white t-shirt, black shorts and trainers**.

Parents are invited to watch the children complete their events by standing behind the nursery garden fence. This will allow the children to enjoy their events with less distractions and will help the Nursery staff to keep all the children safe.

We are hoping for sunny weather on both dates, however if the weather is too bad we will postpone Sports Day until Friday 12<sup>th</sup> July. If this is the case, more information will be sent out via a letter and the Leverton app.
