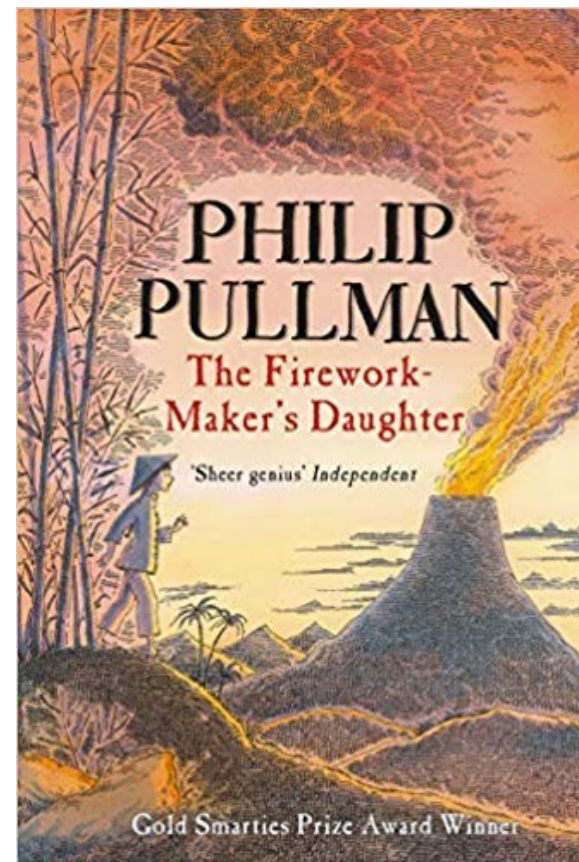


It is important to read everyday: it is enjoyable and will help in all areas of your learning.

Summer Term



Year 4

English

In English, we will continue to develop children's reading and writing using key texts such as, 'The Firework Makers daughter' by Philip Pullman.

We will use this text to develop children's vocabulary, making their sentences more detailed including more adjectives, adverbs and description.



Maths



We will continue to develop our Maths mastery skills in the four operations which will include reasoning and problem solving. At home, please work hard to learn your times tables and inverse operations at speed.

History

We will be learning about the Tudors, focussing on the key aspects of Tudor life such as clothing, food, lifestyle and monarchs.



School trip

We are planning to taking the children out for an external trip to experience Tudor life. More details to follow after Easter.



Science

We will be looking at how the seasonal changes affect the weather through two topics: sound and electricity. We will think about why we get storms in Autumn, why we get thunder and lightning, and why thunder makes a sound.



Art and Design



We will learn about different techniques to create patterns using tie-dye.

Design & Technology

We will learn about different artefacts from the Tudors period creating book sleeve.



Music



We will be learning about rhythm, pulse and pitch. The song we will be learning is 'Blackbird' by The Beatles. We will be listening, appraising, singing and playing instruments.

Computing

We will learn about writing for different audiences, effective searching around the Tudors and investigating different hardware.
