Reading




It is essential that you read with your child every day to ensure their fluency and understanding; and to develop both a love of reading together with a diverse vocabulary.

Autumn Term Learning



Year 4

English

In English, we will continue to develop children's reading and writing using key texts such as, 'How to Train Your Dragon' by Cressida Cowell. We will use this text to develop children's vocabulary, making their sentences increasingly complex by using adjectives, adverbs and description. We will be learning how to structure different texts, using new Alan Pete sentence types to enhance our writing.

We kindly ask you not to watch any of the films until after Christmas to enhance the children's imagination.

Maths

We will be developing the children's knowledge of the four operations this term. Place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. They need a secure and deep understanding of these so that they can use them to reason and solve problems.

History

With cross curricular links to our book, our History topic will be 'Vikings', from 793AD to 1066AD.



Geography



We will learn about the country of England and where the Vikings chose to invade, why they chose those places and how our country changed during the Viking era.

Science

Our first topic is animals including humans. Our focus will be the digestive system and our teeth. We will learn about how our body digests the food we eat, absorbs all the energy we get from eating and how it gets rid of the waste.



Art and Design

We will learn about how to merge colours to create vivid imagery using watercolours and pastels.

Design & Technology

We will learn about the different designs of Viking ships. We will then design and make our own Viking ships. Finally, we will evaluate our designs, considering what the children would do differently and why.



Music

We will be learning to sing the song 'Mamma Mia', after listening and appraising it. Finally, we will perform the song accompanied by a musical

instrument.

Computing

We will learn about the differences between hardware and software; and how software for your computer is designed and developed.





Physical Education

Our indoor PE will be gymnastics and we will be learning how to balance on different body parts. Our outdoor PE will be Tag Rugby.
