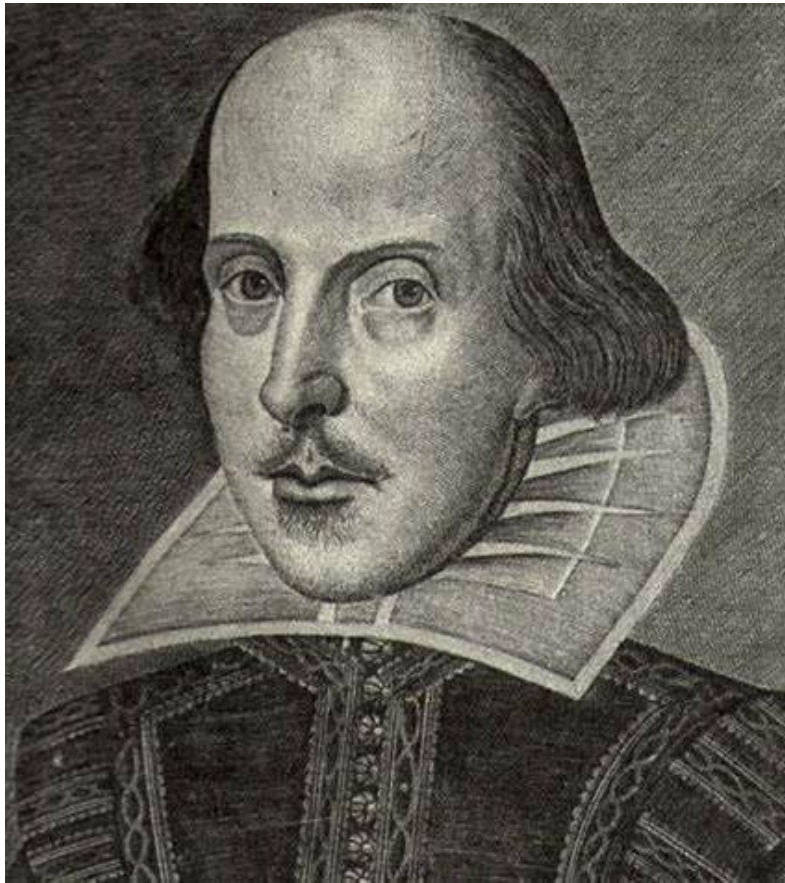


Summer Term



Year 6



English

In English, we will continue to develop children's stamina for writing at length. Children will be expected to use a variety of different sentence structures and a wide range of punctuation, including semi-colons, colons and parenthesis, to produce a high-quality piece of writing. The children will also be introduced to archaic language through Shakespeare.

Maths

We will develop maths mastery by applying our mathematical skills in practical and real life situations and use our reasoning skills when explaining how a problem is solved. We will learn about geometry, shape, statistics and angles throughout this term, while also revising for our SATs.



History

The children will be finding out about our local area: Waltham Abbey and Epping Forest. We will be learning about how the area has developed in the last 100 years.



Geography

We will be learning orienteering skills to help us understand 6 figure grid references and how to read complex maps. We will be identifying human and physical characteristics, key topographical features (including hills, mountains, coasts and rivers) and land-use patterns. We will also learn about river formation and the water cycle.



Science

We will study Electricity and Animals including humans. We will be identifying and naming the main parts of the human circulatory system.

Then we will explain the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood.

Art



We will be focusing on installation art this term, and learning about the street artist Banksy, before creating our own artwork that shares a message.

Music



We will continue to perform using our voices, preparing for our end of year extravaganza!

Computing



For computing we will continue to focus on modern technology such as how networks work and developing our own computer-based quizzes.

Design and Technology



We will be researching bridge designs before designing, making and evaluating our own spaghetti bridges.

Physical Education



We will be developing our sportsmanship skills through more games including track and field athletics. Our PE days are Wednesday pm and Friday pm.
