Uniform expectations:

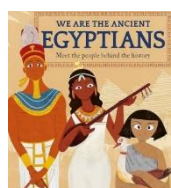

In school, Every day, On time.

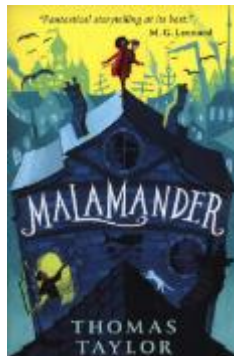
The school will not authorise holiday or other family trips during term time.
