Reading expectations:

Other:

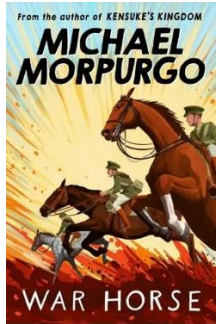
Water bottle to be brought to school daily. Fruit or vegetables only for breaktime snack.

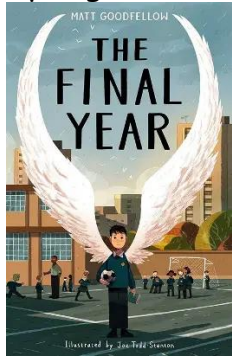
Reading: War horse

Spring Term Key text and Core learning.



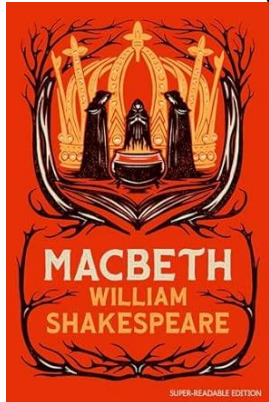
Reading: The Final Year
